

## For wireless internet connection

Here is the explanation of wireless connection procedure. Be sure to confirm whether internet connection with MZK-WNH is available before proceeding wireless connection setup.

The setup procedure below is explained on the basis that MZK-WNH is under the setting of the factory default. If the setting of MZK-WNH is changed, follow the procedure below with referring "User's manual" in the attached CD-ROM.

### About the factory default password of MZK-WNH

When you connect the wireless adapter, Nintendo DS, or PSP which does not support WPS to MZK-WNH, the password set on the factory default is needed. Confirm and note it.

To check factory default password  
The password is shown on the label on the bottom of MZK-WNH as the "WEP Key".  
\*Each product has each password.

### PC setting

Please confirm the following items:

\*For connection with the wireless adapter supports WPS  
When you set WPS with the wireless adapter supports WPS and MZK-WNH, proceed the setting referring "How to set up Wireless LAN" - "Setting up wireless settings on this product" - "Easy set up with button (WPS setup)" in the "User's manual" in the attached CD-ROM.

**Useful Tips**  
WPS (Wi-Fi Protected Setup) means the wireless easy-setup specification which is established by the "Wi-Fi alliance" (industry organization for wireless LAN). This function eases the wireless LAN setting and security setting with the combination of the wireless adapter supports WPS. The WPS button is located on the rear side of MZK-WNH as you can see the picture showed on the right.

\*For connection with the wireless adapter which does not supports WPS  
The security as shown the table below is set on MZK-WNH as the factory default. Set wireless connection to MZK-WNH by setting the same security to the wireless adapter.


### Setting for Nintendo DS

1 Insert the game software supports Wi-Fi connection in the Nintendo DS and start up the software by power on.

2 Launch [Wi-Fi connection setup] display.  
\*The displayed string will vary depending on the kind of the game software.  
\*About [Wi-Fi connection setup], refer to the user's manual attached to the software.


3 Nintendo Wi-Fi Connection Setup

7 Input the WEP key described on the label on the bottom of MZK-WNH.  
8 The settings for that connection will be saved.  
9 Touch [OK] to test the connection.  
10 When [Connection Successful.] is displayed, setup is succeeded.  
\*About the operation of Nintendo DS, refer to the user's manual attached to the Nintendo DS.




### Setting for PSP


1 Power on PSP, and then shift the wireless LAN switch to the on position.  
7 Choose [Settings]-[Network Settings] on the home menu.



2 Input the WEP key written on the label on the bottom of MZK-WNH by English one byte characters.  
8 Choose "Easy" from "Address Setting", and then push the right hand key to proceed to the next window.




3 Choose the network connection name from the new connection list.  
9 Input arbitrary name as the connection name, push the right hand key to proceed to the next window, and confirm the setup.



4 Choose [Scan], and then push the right hand key to display the SSID list.  
10 After confirming the setup, push the right hand key to proceed to the next window, and then push **button** to save the set contents.



5 Choose "planexuser" from the list, push **button**, and then push the right hand key to proceed to the next window.  
11 Confirmation of the internet connection will be started automatically. When you can confirm the connection, setup is completed.
